THE VINTAGE:

The Great Southern region and surrounding areas had an abundant winter and spring rainfall, then with little to no rain over the summer months. Most varieties achieved ripeness at relatively low sugar levels. Yields were relatively low but of excellent quality.

THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-harvested and grapes were gently de-stemmed. The free-run juice was fermented using natural yeasts, followed by a long, cool fermentation between 10-12°c.

THE WINE:

Chalky mineral aromatics with lemon and lime. A tight knit acidity, chalky mineral flavours coming though on the pallet. Acidity is long and fine with a steely structure and long finish.

DRINK WITH:

Freshly shucked Oysters.
