## 2020 Gin Gin Chardonnay

### THE VINTAGE:

Low rainfall and warm temperatures in spring resulted in a very early harvest. All varietals performed exceptionally well with the standout being Cabernet Sauvignon.

### THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-picked and whole-bunch pressed directly into 60% new French oak, 40% 1 year old French oak from a combination of forests – Vosges, Tronçais and Allier. Juice naturally fermented in barrel with only 10% allowed to go through full malolactic fermentation.

### THE WINE:

Dominant aromas of barley sugar, citrus blossom and mineral – typical of the Gingin clone. Constructed with ample texture and a long, fine acidity.
