THE VINTAGE:

A very challenging year with above average rainfall. Careful fruit selection and canopy management made all the difference with expressive white wines with longevity due to the long, slow ripening. The northern end of the Margert River, Wilyabrup and Yallingup experienced very different condition to the south. Reds are very perfumed and long in flavour with abundant tannins.

THE WINEMAKING:

Held on skins for 6 hours to pick up a slight pink hue and gently pressed with 50% of the juice fermented in 1 & 2 year old oak for 6 weeks. Bottled immediately after fermentation.

THE WINE:

Some barrel fermented notes with a brightness, lightness and complexity. Rose petal, musk and pomegranate. Fine lingering acidity and length.
