THE VINTAGE:

An exceptional vintage with rainfall falling at just the right times, Rieslings are some of the best in recent memory with expression of floral aromas and balanced acidities. Cabernet and Shiraz from Frankland are exceptional with tannin and colour. Chardonnay and Pinot from the sub-region of Porongurup are exceptional examples.

THE WINEMAKING:

Parcels of Shiraz were harvested across the regions of Margaret River & Frankland River. Gentle winemaking techniques were employed to keep tannins soft and expressive. A combination of 2 and 3 year old oak were used for maturation.

THE WINE:

A softly textured Shiraz with red flowers, black spice and blueberry.
