THE VINTAGE:

The region experienced a cool and dry season with excellent winter rains, which allowed for good yields and exceptional quality in both whites and reds. The whites, in particular, were outstanding with bright acidity and intense fruit flavours, earning a rating of 8.5/10. The reds were also impressive, with good structure and a rating of 8/10.

THE WINEMAKING:

Parcels of Shiraz were harvested across the regions of Margaret River & Frankland River. Gentle winemaking techniques were employed to keep tannins soft and expressive. A combination of 2 and 3 year old oak were used for maturation.

THE WINE:

A softly textured Shiraz with red flowers, black spice and blueberry.
