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### 2013 Ad Hoc Wallflower Riesling

*"Riesling, the shy and unassuming grape"*

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**The vintage:** The Great Southern received a below average Winter rainfall, resulting in lower yields than in the previous vintage. A warmer January-February saw mild and dry conditions, allowing the fruit to ripen through to late March.

**The winemaking:** Grapes were selected from various sites across the Great Southern. Great attention to harvest dates along with gentle de-stemming, minimal use of sulphur and using free-run juice from select parcels of fruit ensured the elegance and purity of flavour was maintained.

**The wine:** Almost transparent in colour, this wine shows great purity and refinement. A fragrant bouquet, with flavours of lemon peel and bath salts all carried along by a velvety texture and long fine acid.

**Drink with:** Beer-battered whiting with tartare sauce and lemon.
