The Vintage: The 2011 season was long and dry. This resulted in intense fruit with small berries and wines with great colour and character.

The Winemaking: Selected yeasts and fermentation methods and very gentle treatment of the fruit were employed.

The Wine: Black cherries, plums with rich, spicy and warm aromas. Silky soft, long fine tannins, finishing with a sweet spot of black fruit across the palate.
