2012 WALLFLOWER RIESLING
“Riesling, the shy and unassuming grape”

The vintage: A very moderate season in the lead up to harvest allowed the Frankland vines to produce fruit with expressive Grenache flavours and complex tannin structure.

The winemaking: Fruit was harvested at night and gently de-stemmed. Only the free run portion of the juice was used for this wine. Natural yeasts combined with long cool fermentation at 10-12°C.

The wine: Intense lemon and lime with white spice and underlying wet stone nuances. The wine is softly textured with citrus flavours following through onto the palate. The acid is long and persistent with a flavoursome finish.

Drink with: Pork Buns.
