# 2015 Cruel Mistress Pinot Noir

#### THE VINTAGE:

Yields were low with most varieties achieving ripeness at relatively low sugar levels. Fruit picked was of excellent quality, resulting in crisp and refreshing wines.

#### THE WINEMAKING:

Sourced from several locations in the Great Southern, the fruit was fermented using a combination of wild fermentation, selected yeasts and 1-3 year old French oak for 6 months prior to bottling.

## THE WINE:

The nose shows graphite and minerals, juicy black cherries. A hint of spicy oak plays a supporting role. The palate is softly textured, fresh and vibrant, the flavours of black cherry and earthy beetroot carried along by a fine long acid finish.
